TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR FREE TRIAL

Last Updated: 12th January 2011

Please read these terms and conditions, which apply to the UTrain free trial, carefully before submitting your request. By requesting a free trial you agree to be bound by these terms and conditions.

In these terms MTS means:

The person requesting a free trial of UTrain is referred to as the “enquirer”.

FREE TRIAL ACCESS

The UTrain e-learning package may be provided in one of three ways:

1. In the virtual environment for learning provided by Mourne Training Services, namely e-MTS.
2. As training materials which can be hosted by the customer on an in-house intranet, Learning Management System (LMS) or similar.
3. On CD-ROM.

The free trial involves access to a virtual classroom in e-MTS where all the training materials associated with UTrain may be viewed. These include:

- Access to the full training videos
- Samples of the exercises and solutions
- Review and assessment e-learning modules

The enquirer will be supplied (by email) with a username and a password to enable access to the free trial classroom. The access will be limited to a period of 2 hours, which is sufficient time to sample all the training materials. The free trial is only offered on working days, i.e. Monday to Friday inclusive.

The supplied username and password is supplied only for the use of the enquirer, it is a non-transferable licence and should not be passed on to anyone else.

Access to the internet is required for the free trial.

ELIGIBILITY

This free trial is not offered as a training resource but as an opportunity for genuine buyers to sample UTrain. The UTrain package is aimed at scientific companies and laboratories, and educational institutions. Therefore the free trial is only available to representatives of these.

Enquirers should have the required authorisation to purchase UTrain or be in a position to recommend the purchase of UTrain.

MTS reserves the right to refuse the offer of the free trial if:

- It is suspected that the enquirer is, or has links to, a commercial training organisation.
- It is suspected that the enquirer does not represent a scientific company, a laboratory, an educational institution or similar.
- The email address provided by the enquirer does not contain the domain name of the company or organisation that they represent. The free trial will not be offered to enquirers whose email address contains domain names including, but not limited to, the following: Hotmail; Yahoo; Gmail; etc.
- There is any reason to suspect that the request is for unauthorised purposes.

COMPATIBILITY

The UTrain free trial requires access to the internet. A broadband speed of approximately 1 mega bytes per second (mbps) is sufficient to play the training videos but the free trial provides an opportunity for the enquirer to test how well the videos play on their organisation's network.

The training videos in UTrain are played using a Flash player. The protocols in the IT networks of some organisations restrict the use of Flash and thus the free trial allows the enquirer to test compatibility and to liaise with their IT department if necessary.

MTS takes responsibility for ensuring that the e-MTS site is accessible for the free trial but cannot take responsibility for the broadband speed at the enquirer's site or the IT protocols which are put in place by the enquirer's organisation IT group.

COPYRIGHT

All UTrain training materials are protected by copyright. You may not modify, copy, reproduce, re-publish, upload, post, transmit or distribute in any way any of the UTrain

training materials. Any unauthorised use of the training materials is strictly prohibited and will constitute an infringement of MTS copyright.

Note that all user activities are automatically logged by the e-MTS administration system. Any unauthorised use of the training materials is strictly prohibited and will constitute an infringement of MTS copyright.

PRIVACY

The information collected from the enquirer at the time they request the free trial is stored by MTS and is used purely to fulfil the request. There are no circumstances under which this information may be passed to a third party.

If the enquirer has ticked the box *I would like to would like to receive the MTS e-newsletter "Analyse This"*, then the e-newsletter will be sent monthly to the email address provided. There is a link provided on all e-newsletters to allow the enquirer to unsubscribe, should they wish to.

PAYMENT

There is no charge associated with the trial of UTrain and acceptance of the free trial does not place any obligation on the enquirer to purchase UTrain, nor is there any obligation on MTS to sell UTrain to the enquirer.

Details of the cost of the UTrain package will be provided to the enquirer as part of the free trial communications.
